Billing Decisions fully supports virtually every billing scenario:

Commissions are automatically released based on the agent's configurable commission basis method (written, paid, or earned premium). A monthly commission statement is produced, and commissions are disbursed via a check extract or ACH.
- **MGA Payables**
Billing Decisions automatically tracks premium payable to the insurance company net of commission, and at month-end, automatically generates a disbursement to the writing company.

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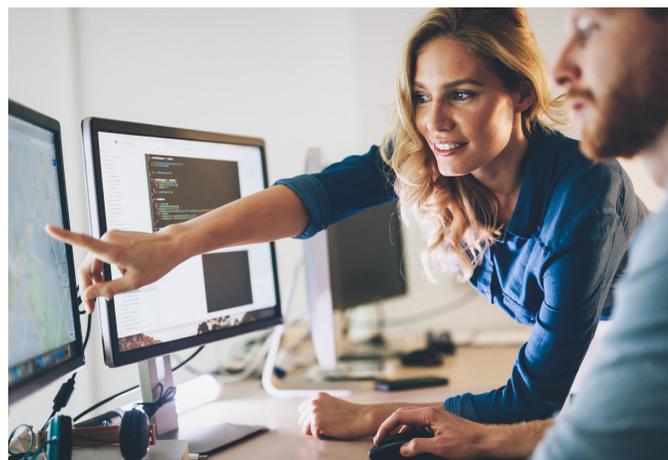
